The New Palestine Town Council met on Wednesday July 17, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. at the New Palestine Town Hall. Larry Jonas called the meeting to order. Clint Bledsoe and Jan Jarson attended.

Minutes- Clint Bledsoe made the motion to accept the minutes of July 6, 2013. Jan Jarson seconded and the motion carried with 3 ayes and 0 nays. No recording of minutes was taken on 7-6 or 7-17.

OLD BUSINESS

ANNEX WEST – Town Manager Dave Book will have O.W. STREET PAVING- Town Manager Dave Book reported that the paving on 400 S. east of Bittner as contracted with Hancock County had been done 7-15. Crim & Sons will be paving per the agreement all other areas starting the 22nd and be done by the time school starts.

SEWER GENERATOR – Sewer Manager Dave Book reported that the generator test had been run and all is working. They will test the generator each Monday. Mr. Book is checking into the generator emissions annual testing and extended warranties.


Larry Jonas and Jan Jarson attended the Service Advisory Board meeting this week.

CLAIMS – The Council signed claims 13289 through 13316


The meeting was then adjourned by motion from Jan Jarson and Clint Bledsoe with second. The motion carried with 3 ayes and 0 nays.


