

TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

The New Palestine Town Council met on Wednesday June 19, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. at the New Palestine Town Hall. Larry Jonas called the meeting to order. Clint Bledsoe attended. Jan Jarson absent.

Minutes- Clint Bledsoe made the motion to accept the minutes of June 1, 2013. Larry Jonas seconded and the motion carried with 2 ayes and 0 nays.

OLD BUSINESS

STREET LIGHTS –Town Manager Dave Book will have the final walk through with Duke.

GENERATOR- Sewer Manager Dave Book reported that the job was 70% done with the actual generator to be here in two weeks.

ANNEX WEST- Town Manager Dave Book reported that Hollis and Shirley Kennedy on west side of Greenfield Bank had signed a petition to be in the annexation. A revised map will be done soon. Some of the responses had come in and hope to have all by end of week.

TOURISM VIDEO-Larry Jonas reported that the New Palestine Chamber of Commerce had voted to do the full \$4,500.00 category in the Hancock tourism web page. The Town will be included in what the Chamber does on the Education section.

CHAMBER JULY 4TH CELEBRATION- Town Manager Dave Book reported that the street department will lend the street cones for chamber use and that the police department will do traffic flow for the morning walk/run.

NEW BUSINESS

WESTSIDE DRIVE AGREEMENT-Larry Jonas moved to accept Triad Associates agreement for \$3737.00 for the Westside Dr. turn lane. Clint Bledsoe seconded and the motion carried with 2 ayes and 0 nays. Pres. Jonas signed the agreement.

EBAY SELL POLICE CAR- Marshal Ehle reconfirmed the selling of the 2006 Ford on Ebay with the council. Both Jonas and Bledsoe affirmed using Ebay to sell the 2006 vehicle.

PERMITS- Planning Commissioner Jim Robinson reported that he was looking into roofing and demolition permits and was talking with other communities for input. He is also meeting with Alan Edon on the property 110 E. Main St. hoping to resolve the building problems soon.




2014 Budget meeting set for July 11 at 5PM.

CLAIMS – The Council signed claims 13196 through 13243


The meeting was then adjourned by motion from Clint Bledsoe and Larry Jonas with second. The motion carried with 2 ayes and 0 nays.


