The New Palestine Town Council met on Wednesday March 19, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. at the New Palestine Town Hall. Jan Jarson called the meeting to order. Clint Bledsoe and Larry Jonas attended.

Minutes- Larry Jonas made the motion to approve the minutes of March 1, 2014. Clint Bledsoe seconded and the motion carried with 3 ayes and 0 nays.

OLD BUSINESS

2014 PAVING QUOTE- Town Council had given their recommendations for street paving that needs to be done for 2014.

NEW BUSINESS

CUBSCOUT DERBY-Caralee Griffith representative for local Cub Scouts have received the approval from Marshal Ehle and Town Manager Book to have a derby on the north side of the Bittner Rd. bridge on May 18 if the council agrees. This is a first try and all traffic control, parking, signage, and participant staging area will have to be considered. The Town requires a certificate of insurance with the Town named additional insured. By general consensus the council agreed to the Derby with Marshal Ehle being involved in all details.

KEYSTONE SOFTWARE AGREEMENT-Larry Jonas made the motion to approve \$5,315.00 for all Keystone software annual agreement for budget, payroll and billing. Clint Bledsoe seconded and the motion carried with 3 ayes and 0 nays.



RED FLAG –CLOUD STORAGE OF COMPUTER BACKUPS -Larry Jonas made the motion to approve \$269.99 with Walker IT for all computer backup storage. Clint Bledsoe seconded and the motion carried with 3 ayes and 0 nays.




The meeting was then adjourned by motion from Larry Jonas and Clint Bledsoe with second. The motion carried with 3 ayes and 0 nays.




Larry Jonas
