The New Palestine Town Council met on Saturday November 3, 2018 at 8:00 a.m. at the New Palestine Town Hall. Clint Bledsoe called the meeting to order with Jan Jarson and Brandee Bastin present. Pledge

**Minutes** – Jan Jarson made the motion to approve the minutes of September 19, 2018. Brandee Bastin seconded and the motion carried with 3 ayes and 0 nays.

**OLD BUSINESS**

**STELLAR RESOLUTION** – Town Manager Dave Book reported the Stellar team had been busy. Drone shots, filmed interviews and voice overs for the Google Earth fly over are being done. They are meeting twice a week to work on the presentation with a dress rehearsal to be Nov. 14. Presentation due 11-15.

**CRYSTAL HEIGHTS MS-4 REPAIRS** - Town Manager Dave Book reported that he had walked the sites again with Brad Patton and Jim Robinson. A new quote is \$45,229.05 by Wilkins Lawn & Landscape LLC for Crystal Hts. and Harting Farms subdivisions for subsurface tiles to be run through the drainage areas. Jan Jarson made the motion to approve the MS-4 drainage repair with Wilkins Lawn over a 3 year period. Brandee Bastin seconded and the motion carried with 3yes and 0 nays.

**SEWER PLANT EXPANSION-** Town Manager Dave Book reported not much was done this past week with 4 inches of rain. Work is ongoing with completion to be in 3 to 4 weeks.

**NEW BUSINESS**

**ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL** – Skip Kuker with the Hancock County Economic Development Council presented the developments they had worked with during the past year.

**EDC BONDS ORDINANCE #110318-** Gregg Morelock presented the Economic Development Bond information with the bonds not to exceed \$3,000,000.00 and more details to be worked out by all parties involved. Jan Jarson made the motion to read by title only Economic Development Revenue Bonds Ordinance #110318. Brandee Bastin abstained due to working for the hospital. Clint Bledsoe seconded and the motion carried with 2 ayes and 0 nays. Gregg Morelock read by title only. Presentations with many details were made by Buzz Krohn and Ron Pritzke. Jan Jarson made the motion to pass on first reading Economic Development Revenue Bonds Ordinance #110318. Clint Bledsoe seconded and the motion carried with 2 ayes and 0 nays. Passage set for 11-21.

**SEWER LINE CAMERA & RECORDER**– Town Manager Dave Book presented a quote of \$12,641.40 with Best Equipment for camera and recorder equipment needed to replace old equipment. He stated this is the best known equipment out for use. Jan Jarson made the motion to approve the purchase of the Best Equipment camera not to exceed \$12,641.40. Brandee Bastin seconded and the motion carried with 3yes and 0 nays.

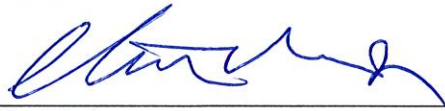
**BRIDGE US 52 CONSTRUCTION** - Street Commissioner Steve Pool presented a letter to be sent to Gov. Holcomb to request that the US 52 bridge construction project does not completely close US 52 during the 4 to 5 months of construction. Brandee Bastin made the motion to approve the letter and Jan Jarson seconded and the motion carried with 3 ayes and 0 nays.

**SEWER PLANT EXPANSION**– Town Manager Dave Book reported that more equipment was needed for \$12,000.00 with total cost of addition to be \$15,000.00. This is currently outside the project and he working on it becoming a change order and included in the project.

**CGS TRASH REMOVAL**- Clerk-Treasurer Becky Hilligoss reported that she had been informed that the trash removal day was being changed back to Wednesdays by CGS and to start by the first week of December 2018.

**CLAIMS** –Brandee Bastin made the motion to approve claims 19148 through 19190. Jan Jarson seconded with 3 ayes and 0 nays.

The meeting was then adjourned by motion from Jan Jarson and seconded by Brandee Bastin and the motion carried with 3 ayes and 0 nays.
